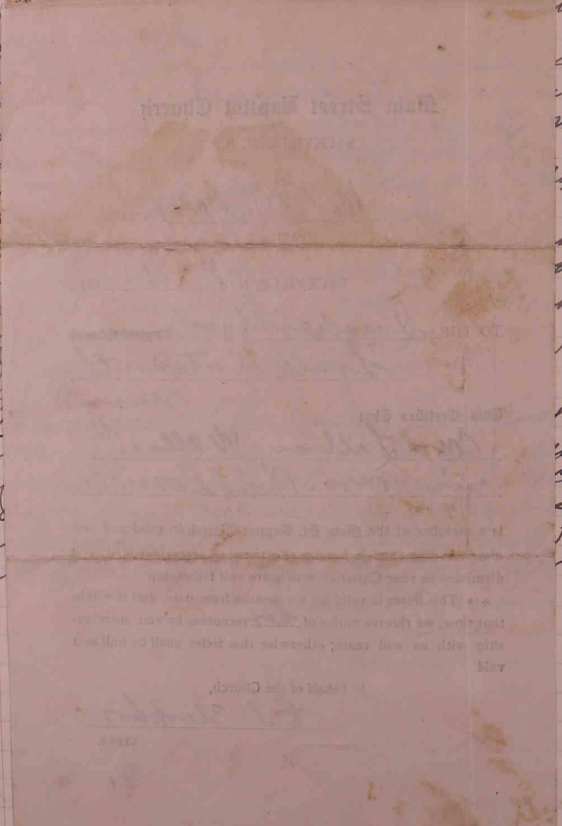

MEMORIAL TO JOHN A. CORNELL.

On June 22nd, 1942, John A. Cornell of Dartmouth, Mass., passed away at the age of 73.
